Each fifth grade classroom nurtured and hatched out salmon that are a part of a program to return salmon to the San Joaquin River where they disappeared when Millerton Lake was completed. Each classroom had a 10 gallon tank and were given 40-50 eggs over Christmas break. Once the salmon hatched, they began to lose their yoke sacs and look like little fish that could potentially survive in the river. Hopefully one of our Lincoln Salmon will swim out to the ocean and return in 3-5 years to spawn. This has been quite an experience for our teachers and students as they have taken notes on their observations of the salmon. After releasing the salmon, our fifth grade went out to Millerton on Wednesday and toured the fish hatchery and the damn. Our GATE students will return in March to release about 150 more salmon to the river at Lost Lake.



In addition to raising salmon, our fifth grade teachers and students are getting ready for Science Fair at Clovis West on February 21st. All 5th graders work on a science project, learning how to use scientific method to solve a problem that they are not sure about. Science Fair projects selected to move on will be judged by AP Science teachers and students at Clovis West along with projects from all elementary schools in the CW area. This night gives our students a taste of what it will be like when they are taking science classes at CW.
