Verhalen's Vision

Lincoln is in our second year as a PBIS school. What is that? PBIS is a program (Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports) that attempts to systemize behaviors and reward positive behaviors. You may have heard about ROAR tickets that are given to students when a staff member recognizes them for doing a good thing. These tickets are then used to buy items in our ROAR store after eating lunch. The store is open every Friday. Some students save the tickets to buy a big item, others buy pencils for five tickets or a piece of candy as soon as they get five tickets. Students get to choose how to use their tickets. The research says that these rewards, earning a ticket or attempting to earn a ticket, changes the behavior choices students make. Another part of PBIS is our ROAR expectations for behavior in the classroom, hallway, restroom, library, cafeteria, and on the playground. With these expectations in place, students then are not surprised when they get a consequence for not meeting Lincoln's behavioral expectations.

In other news, we have two of our cross country teams competing for area championships when we travel to Fort Washington, 4th grade boys and 5-6 grade girls. Great job to all who are competing.
